A NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS



To commemorate the very first Eucharistic Procession since the Reformation (following the Restoration of the Catholic Hierarchy in England and Wales in September 1850) a National Eucharistic Congress is to be held at St Mary's College, Oscott on Saturday, 14th September. The Eucharistic Congress is also part of our national preparations for the 2025 Holy Year.
