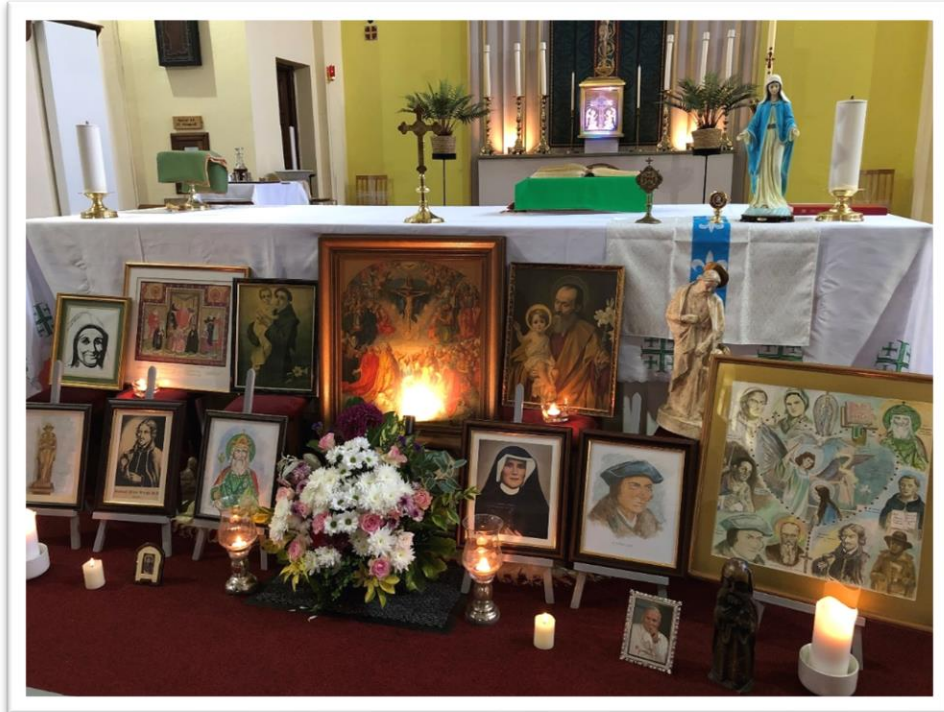

All Souls Day falls on Saturday, **2nd November**

Masses at St Edward's will be at:

10.00 am and 6.30 pm (*Bereavement Mass*).

At **Burton Latimer** and **Rothwell**, Masses for the *Holy Souls* will be on **Sunday**.

During these Masses we will pray especially for those parishioners, who passed away in the last year. I would like to invite those who lost their loved ones since last November (2023). We could put photographs or even Orders of Service of those who died, on the steps of the Sanctuary as we did last year.



In the Sanctuary you can find a basket with envelopes in which you can put a card with the names of the deceased. You can also use ordinary envelopes for this. Please return your envelopes to the Church (put it in the collection basket) or to the Parish office (put it through the letter box). Your donation can be placed in the envelope. Mass for Holy Souls will be offered for them during the month of November and the year ahead.

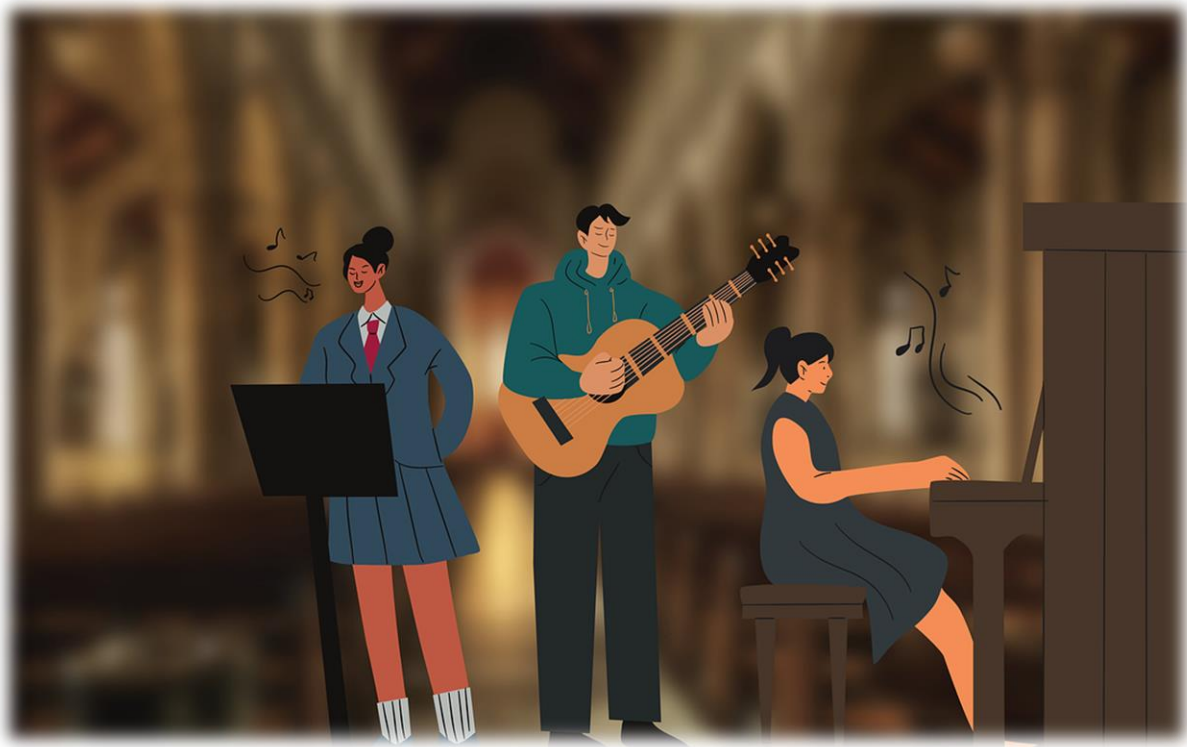

Programme: Each group will be given approximately 10 minutes to introduce itself and sing three hymns. Refreshments will be hosted by the members of our parish groups at the back of the church.

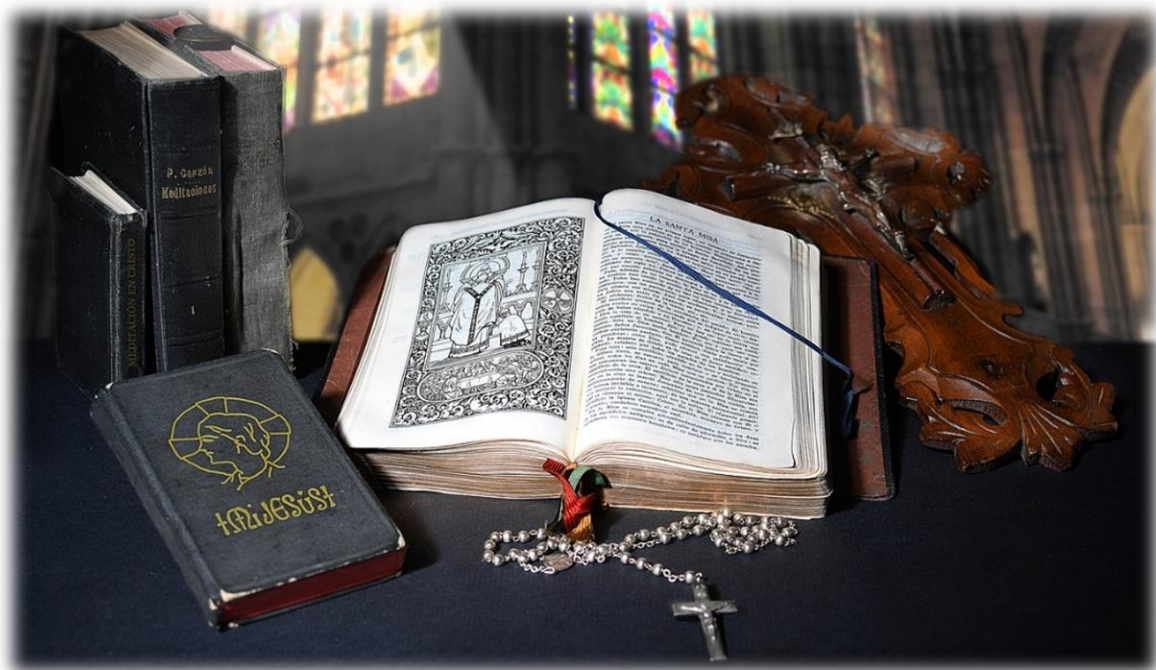
A MESSAGE FROM THE PARISH CHOIR

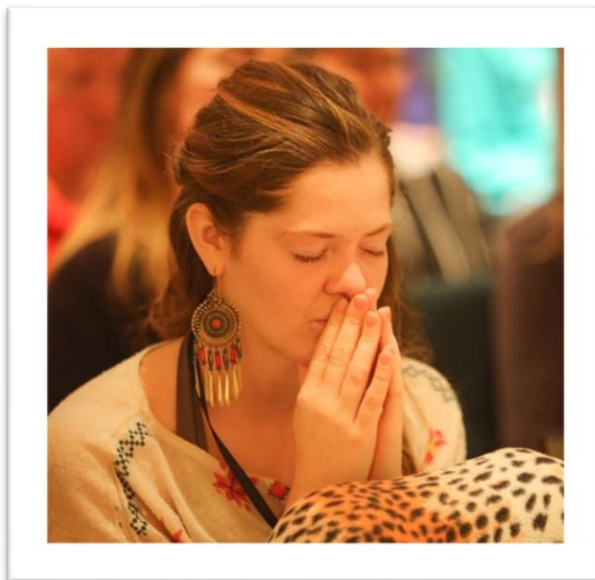

DEVOTIONS AT ST EDWARD'S

Attending Sunday Mass is something, which we as Catholics do, not only because it is our duty but because our souls gather strength thanks to the Sacrifice of Our Lord. Yet, there are many more occasions when we can come to church, when we can show our appreciation to God, when we can worship, praise and thank Him, when we can share our worries with Him. As well as times of quiet devotion, the church calendar in our parish gives us an opportunity for more organised prayer.



- >>> **The Angelus** prayer we say after each Tuesday and Wednesday Mass.
- >>> **First Friday Adoration** - on each first Friday of the month adoration starts at 6 pm and is concluded by the Litany to The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus and benediction.
- >>> **Weekday adoration** - on **Tuesdays** 30 minutes before morning Mass
and on **Fridays** 30 minutes before evening Mass.
- >>> **Lent Time - The Stations of the Cross** are led by parishioners after Wednesday Masses at 10 am, and before Friday Masses, that is at 6.15 pm.
- >>> **Easter Time** - we pray **Divine Mercy Chaplet** on Divine Mercy Sunday at 3 pm, and during the week following Divine Mercy Sunday after weekday Masses.
- >>> **May** is the month of Our **Blessed Mother**.
We pray the **Litany of Loreto** after each weekday Mass.
- >>> **June** is the month of the **Most Sacred Heart of Jesus**.
We pray the **Litany to the Heart of Jesus** after each weekday Mass.
- >>> **July** is the month of the **Most Precious Blood of Jesus**.
We pray the **Litany to the Blood of Jesus** after each weekday Mass.
- >>> **October** is the month of the **Holy Rosary**.
We pray the Rosary 30 minutes before each weekday Mass.
- >>> **November** is the month of **all the faithful departed**. We pray the Rosary or Divine Mercy Chaplet for those who have passed away, after each weekday Mass.
