We invite everybody to the celebration on


Friday, 22nd November at 6.30 pm.

It is for anybody who feels the need to be strengthened by the Lord. When you come to the steps of the sanctuary, please hold out your hands which will be anointed. Your forehead will also be anointed.

• The Priest takes the oil and anoints the sick person. He anoints first on the forehead, saying: Through this holy anointing, may the Lord in his love and mercy help you with the grace of the Holy Spirit.

You will answer: Amen.

• Then on the hands, saying: May the Lord who frees you from sin save you and raise you up.

You will answer: Amen.

FRIENDS OF THE HOLY LAND

This Christmas, there will be no celebrations in Bethlehem - AGAIN.

Without tourism, Bethlehem's lifeblood which supports 80% of the population, unemployment has surged. With the borders closed, there is no option to seek work in Israel. Prices have skyrocketed, residents are traumatised by the constant fear and anxiety for the future while their daily lives are restricted by checkpoints and roadblocks.

This brutal war has already claimed over 700 lives in the West Bank and devastated countless others. Parents have run out of words to comfort their children as their loved ones perish in neighbouring Gaza, barely 50 miles away. Nearly every family has lost someone.

Yet we have not lost HOPE and neither should you. Over the past year, I have seen hope shine more brightly than ever through the Christian community in the West Bank. Though they number around 45,000, less than 1% of the population, the impact they make is remarkable.
