A FEW THOUGHTS FROM LAST SUNDAY'S HOMILY



‘Today we tend to underestimate the power of the *Sacrament of Anointing*. It is because for many years we were wrongly calling this sacrament ‘*the last rites*’ and we associated it with imminent death and with the end of life. How wrong that is. Jesus left us this wonderful sacrament not as a last blessing before we die, but to heal us, to give us life, to heal our body, but most importantly to heal our soul from all the wounds caused by sin. The sacrament of healing can be received many times during one’s lifetime, not only just before death, and anyone who is a baptised catholic can and should receive this sacrament of healing, when for example they feel depressed, lonely, sick or before undergoing surgery, or really at any time when they feel that they need God’s healing and grace.

Maybe today you may think of someone whom you know, who you think would benefit from this sacrament of healing. Tell him or her that it is available to them. Or perhaps you yourself are in need of this sacrament of healing. Ask for it, appreciate it, and thank God for it. He will surely give you His grace and the strength you need in your daily life - both in sickness and in health’.

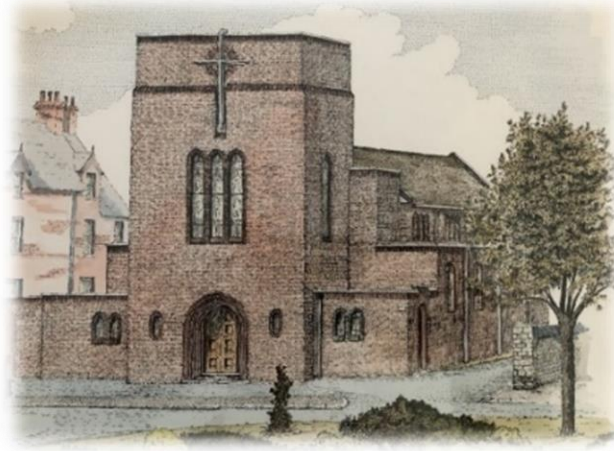

A NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS



To commemorate the very first Eucharistic Procession since the Reformation (following the Restoration of the Catholic Hierarchy in England and Wales in September 1850) a National Eucharistic Congress is to be held at St Mary's College, Oscott on Saturday, 14th September. The Eucharistic Congress is also part of our national preparations for the 2025 Holy Year. >>> **June** is the month of the **Most Sacred Heart of Jesus**.

We pray the **Litany to the Heart of Jesus** after each weekday Mass.

>>> **July** is the month of the **Most Precious Blood of Jesus**.

We pray the **Litany to the Blood of Jesus** after each weekday Mass.

>>> **Lent Time - The Stations of the Cross** are led by parishioners after
Wednesday Masses at 10 am, and before Friday Masses, that is at 6.15 pm.

>>> **Easter Time** - we pray **Divine Mercy Chaplet** on Divine Mercy Sunday at 3 pm,
and during the week following Divine Mercy Sunday after weekday Masses.

We pray the Rosary 30 minutes before each weekday Mass.

>>> **November** is the month of **all the faithful departed**. We pray the Rosary or Divine
Mercy Chaplet for those who have passed away, after each weekday Mass.
